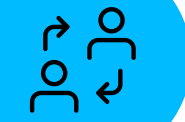

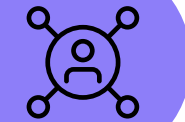

Joint WHPA statements to WHO governing bodies; side events at World Health Assembly



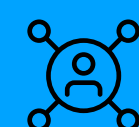
Advocacy

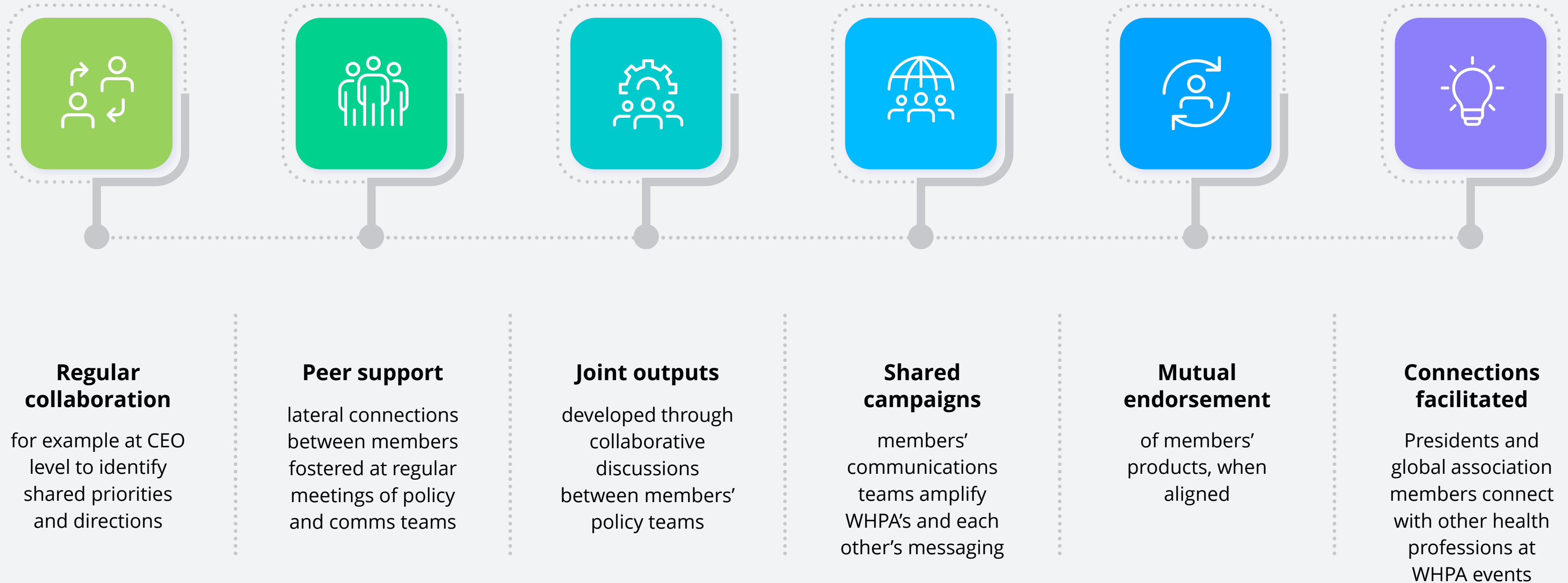


WHPA Presidents (seated) and CEOs (standing), May 2026
